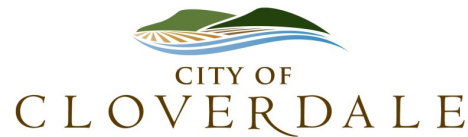

About the City:

Incorporated in 1872, the City of



Cloverdale is located 80 miles north of San Francisco and 80 miles east of the Pacific coast on Hwy 101. The City is 2.7 square miles, with a population of 9,100.

Cloverdale is ideally situated in the northern Alexander Valley basin in Sonoma County — the heart of the wine country. Recreation opportunities abound in the City and its surroundings, including the 70 acre Russian River Park and 420 acres of protected hillside open space, and beautiful Lake Sonoma, located minutes from town.

About the Position:

The 4.5 MGD capacity Direct-Filtration Water Treatment Plant serves about 3,500 connections. The Water Treatment Plant Operator is responsible for the full range of treatment plant responsibilities within the legal parameters of his/her level of certification.

Under general supervision of the Senior Water Plant Operator:

- Operates, monitors and maintains all plant equipment, components, and related facilities

- Monitors reservoirs for alarms and takes corrective actions; prepares daily control data sheets; maintains a log of daily works and tests performed; may compile necessary regulatory reports and records
- Conducts regular on-site inspections and adjusts plant and system operations
- Programs the SCADA system at the water plant and pump stations
- Performs basic and skilled water quality laboratory testing and analysis
- Performs maintenance and construction work as directed on the water treatment plant and related facilities
- Ability to work weekends and holidays, and during non-business hours on an on-call basis

Desired Minimum Qualifications:

- Grade II Water Treatment Plant Operator Certificate and ability to obtain Grade II Distribution Certification, CA driver's license.
- Two years' experience in the operation/maintenance of a water treatment plant, with one year equivalent to Cloverdale Water Treatment Plant Operator I
- One year of maintenance, construction or related experience



- High school diploma or equivalent, with supplemental coursework in chemistry, mathematics or a related field
