RESOLUTION NO. 061 --2018**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE SUPPORTING THE ROAD  
REPAIR ACCOUNTABILITY ACT (SB1) AND OPPOSING PROPOSITION 6.**

**WHEREAS,** In April 2017, Governor Jerry Brown signed in law the Road Repair Accountability Act, also known as SB1. This landmark funding program increased the gas tax, diesel tax and vehicle registration fees to provide about \$5.4 billion annually to invest in State and local roads. SB1 also puts people to work. Each \$1 billion invested supports approximately 13,000 jobs statewide; and

**WHEREAS,** The City of Cloverdale directly benefits from SB1 and expects to receive about \$150,000 in 2019 to spend on our local roads. This is about three times the funding the City received each year from the "old gas tax" in 2017 and will allow the City to expand road maintenance activities beyond filling potholes; and

**WHEREAS,** SB1 is expected to provide to the City of Cloverdale a total of about \$1.7 million over 10 years; and

**WHEREAS,** Proposition 6 seeks to repeal the Road Repair Accountability Act (SB1), which would deny the City of Cloverdale essential funding to repair and reconstruct our roads.


