**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ANIMAL
HOSPITAL OF CLOVERDALE**

WHEREAS, California law requires that cities provide certain services for the prompt and humane care of injured animals; and

WHEREAS, the welfare of persons in Cloverdale requires the control of animals at large; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.04.050 of the Cloverdale Municipal Code authorized the City Council to contract with any responsible organization to perform animal control services, and

WHEREAS, Contractor hereby warrants to the City that Contractor has the qualifications, experience and facilities to provide temporary sheltering and animal care services as described in the attached Agreement in a thorough, competent and professional manner; and

WHEREAS, City desires to retain Contractor pursuant to this Agreement to provide the services described in the attached Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby approves the Agreement for temporary animal sheltering and care between the City and the Animal Hospital of Cloverdale in the form attached hereto, and as approved by the City Attorney, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement for temporary animal sheltering and care services.
