RESOLUTION NO. 95-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE RATIFYING A PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY BY THE CITY MANAGER, ACTING AS THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, DATED OCTOBER 9, 2019, UNDER CHAPTER 2.44 (DISASTER COUNCIL AND EMERGENCY SERVICES) OF THE CLOVERDALE MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATED TO THE PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC (PG&E) POWER SHUTDOWN

WHEREAS, Section 2.44.060 of the Cloverdale Municipal Code empowers the Director of Emergency Services, which is set forth as the City Manager, to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said City is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, on the 9th of October 2019, the City Manager acting as the Cloverdale Director of Emergency Services found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the City of Cloverdale existed related to the Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) Power Shutdown to certain areas within the City of Cloverdale at approximately 3:15 am Wednesday morning; and

WHEREAS, these emergency conditions are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City of Cloverdale; and

WHEREAS, the Cloverdale Director of Emergency Services signed a Proclamation of Local Emergency on the 9th day of October 2019, which is attached and incorporated herein to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, per Section 2.44.060(A) of the Cloverdale Municipal Code, the City Council shall take action to ratify the proclamation of local emergency within seven days thereafter; and

WHEREAS, during the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of the City shall be those prescribed by State Law, by ordinances, and resolutions of the City, and by the City of Cloverdale Emergency Operations Plan, as approved by the City Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cloverdale hereby ratifies the Proclamation of Local Emergency signed by the Director of Emergency Services on the 9th day of October 2019, which is attached and incorporated herein to this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that said local emergency shall be deemed as continuing to exist until proclaimed otherwise by the Director of Emergency Services and the City Council of the City of Cloverdale of the State of California.
