**Existing Building Permits:** The City continues to perform limited building inspections in accordance with the Order of the Health Officer of Sonoma County. This practice is subject to change quickly, given the fluid nature of the emergency situation.

The following inspections are being conducted:

- Inspections related to emergency repairs.
- Inspections related to immediate housing needs, for example, the final inspection for a home or for an affordable housing project.
