RESOLUTION NO. 048-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH COASTLAND CIVIL ENGINEERING TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE VISTA VIEW SLIP-OUT REPAIR PROJECT, IN A FORM APPROVED BY THE CITY ATTORNEY, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE ABILITY TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AMENDMENTS UP TO 10% OF THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT AMOUNT TO ADDRESS ANY UNFORESEEN COMPLEXITIES

WHEREAS, on Presidents' Day weekend in 2017 (Feb17 through 20) a winter storm caused Vista View Drive to slip-out; and

WHEREAS, both the Governor of California and the President of the United States proclaimed a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the proclamations, the Federal Emergency Management Agency and California Office of Emergency Services (FEMA/Cal OES) have been authorized to partially fund damage repairs resulting from this storm; and

WHEREAS, the funding support is allocated per the standard share: 75% FEMA, 18.75% Cal OES, and 6.25% local government; and

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2017, the City of Cloverdale initiated the design and preparation of a construction bid package for the Vista View Slip-out Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, Coastland Civil Engineering (Consultant) provided project management services during the design and construction procurement phase; and

WHEREAS, Consultant's proposal includes a Scope of Services and Projected Budget for the professional services; and

WHEREAS, Consultant proposes a total cost "Not to Exceed Amount" of Seventy-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$77,750.00); and which will be shared by the FEMA/Cal OES grant (93.75%) and account 211-40-402 Vista View Slip Out Fund (6.25%); and

WHEREAS, Staff will request reimbursement of the costs from FEMA/Cal OES. Budget adjustments may be necessary if the costs are not recoverable or exceeds the FEMA/Cal OES grant limit. The justification is that the proposed professional services will manage the repair of Vista View Drive; and


WHEREAS, City staff is requesting the ability to execute contract amendments up to 10% of the contract amount to address any unforeseen professional services and or to address any unforeseen complexities related to the Vista View Slip-out Repair Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cloverdale hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute said amendment to the Professional Services Agreement on behalf of the City.
