- **Measure R** is a 3% utility users' tax extension that will maintain essential community services such as 9-1-1 emergency response services and police dispatchers.
- If you are voting by mail, your ballot must be received – not merely postmarked – by Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2020. Mail ballots may also be returned at Polling Places on Election Day.

The resolution that submitted the Measure and Council-approved ballot question to the voters identified the following priorities for use of the revenue from the UUT: streets and pothole repair, installing City power backup systems for PG&E power shutdowns, preparing and responding to natural disasters/health emergencies, maintaining rapid 911 response, supporting youth and teen programs, and other city services...

The UUT would be extended until ended by the voters...

The Measure provides low-income senior exemptions for telecommunications, electricity, and gas service.
