RESOLUTION NO. 101 –2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE AWARDING A CONTRACT TO PROCURE AND INSTALL FUEL INJECTORS FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT EMERGENCY 600 KW GENERATOR TO PETERSON POWER SYSTEMS OF SANTA ROSA, CA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY AND 71/100 DOLLARS (\$13,290.71); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID PURCHASE CONTRACT AND ANY CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED TEN PERCENT OF PURCHASE CONTRACT AMOUNT

WHEREAS, the Cloverdale Water System is a critical infrastructure system that provides potable water necessary for the health and safety of the City’s residents and business community; and

WHEREAS, the Cloverdale Water System is impacted by Pacific Gas & Electric unplanned electrical outages, and Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) program; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Water Treatment Plant has an emergency backup power supply during electrical outages; and

WHEREAS, the Water Treatment Plant emergency electrical generator’s cooling system was repaired; and

WHEREAS, as repair work on the backup emergency generator exposed fuel leakage within the fuel injectors; and

WHEREAS, immediate repair of the fuel injectors for the backup emergency generator at the Water Treatment Plant is necessary; and

WHEREAS, At the City’s request, Peterson Power Systems of Santa Rosa submitted a quotation for parts and service (procure/install parts); and


WHEREAS, this repair is included in the FY 2020/21 Water Enterprise Fund (Fund 600) to enable the repair of the emergency generator; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cloverdale hereby awards a contract for the repair (parts and service) for the Water Treatment Plant emergency electrical generator to Peterson Power Systems of Santa Rosa, CA in an amount not to exceed THIRTEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY AND 71/100 dollars (\$13,290.71); authorize the City Manager to implement change orders not-to-exceed THIRTEEN HUNDRED TWENTY NINE AND 07/100 dollars (\$1,329.07); and authorizes the City Manager to execute said contract.
