RESOLUTION NO. 106-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE APPROVING A FY 2020-2021 BUDGET AMENDMENT TO INCORPORATE \$66,073.83 IN EXPENDITURES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE HOST SERVER REPLACEMENT; AND APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH KLH CONSULTING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,067.12 FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN HP ENTERPRISE PROLIANT DL 380 HOST SERVER PLUS A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR POTENTIAL COST OVERRUNS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Cloverdale currently has two physical Servers in the Police Department Server Rack, one used for Veeam Backups and one is the VMware Host server which runs six Virtual servers for City Departments and the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Host Server is on an extended 24/7 warranty until August of 2021 and currently has 2.5 TB of disk space of which there is 420 GB of free space; and

WHEREAS, many of the virtual servers that run on this hardware platform are running on Microsoft Windows server 2008 which ended its support of this operating system earlier this year; and

WHEREAS, the police department utilizes the host server to run the Records Incident Management System (RIMS), a critical operational necessity which helps in dispatching officers to calls, classifying calls for service, running records checks and accessing criminal history information; and

WHEREAS, the police department cannot upgrade to the latest version of RIMS because Microsoft has ended support for Microsoft Server 2008 r2, which is currently running the RIMS Server. Without that support, Sunridge Systems will not support an upgrade to the latest version; and

WHEREAS, Cloverdale Police is host to 5 other law enforcement agencies that access their CLETS (California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System) through our message switch and they rely on our RIMS system for their operational needs and each pay yearly dues to help offset the cost for system updates; and

WHEREAS, the servers have reached the end of their productive lifespan and due to their age, the servers cannot be upgraded to newer Windows Server versions and are in critical need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, Public Safety Impact Fund are available to use for this project (510.00.000.42150.000) and will leave an estimated fund balance of \$51,080.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cloverdale hereby approves an Agreement with KLH Consulting in an amount not to exceed \$60,067.12 for the purchase and installation of an HP Enterprise ProLiant DL 380 sever and further authorizes the City Manager to execute said agreement on behalf of the City and amends the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget to include expenditures up to \$66,073.83 (includes 10% contingency) in Fund 510 Public Safety Impact Fund.+


