RESOLUTION NO. 110-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020 DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW AND THEREBY DETERMINING THAT MELANIE BAGBY AND TODD LANDS HAVE BEEN ELECTED TO THE OFFICE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE AND THAT MEASURE R, EXTENSION OF THE UTILITY USERS' TAX WAS APPROVED BY THE VOTERS

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Cloverdale, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined, pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, that approval of this resolution is an administrative activity of the City and will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment and is therefore not a project for purposes of CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 066-2020 adopted June 24, 2020, and Resolution No. 073-2020 adopted July 22, 2020, the Sonoma County Elections Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of votes (ballots) cast for the office of member of the City Council for was 4,744.

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

Melanie Bagby
Mary Ann Brigham
Todd Lands
Nicole Garcia-Hinchliffe
Jenny Candelaria-Orr

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates are as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Cloverdale does declare and determine that: Melanie Bagby and Todd Lands are elected as Members of the City Council for the full term of four years, by a total of 1,610 and 2,222 votes, respectively.

SECTION 5. That the titles of the measure voted upon at the election was as follows:

Measure R To maintain important City services, including: repairing potholes/streets; installing City power backup systems for PG&E power shutdowns; preparing/responding to natural disasters/health emergencies; maintaining rapid 911 response; supporting youth/ teen programs; and other City services; shall Cloverdale’s measure extending the existing voter approved Utility Users Tax at the current 3%, without increasing the rate, until ended by voters, providing \$445,000 annually, exempting low income seniors, requiring citizen oversight, with no money for Sacramento, be adopted? SECTION 6. That the number of votes given at each precinct in favor or against Measure R is listed in Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

SECTION 7. That a majority of the voters of the City of Cloverdale did vote in favor of Measure R, regarding the Utility Users’ Tax by the following vote:

SECTION 8. The City Clerk shall enter in the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City; (2) the names of the person voted for; (3) for what office each person was voted for, (4) the measure voted upon; (5) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against the measure; and (6) the total number of votes given to each person and for and against measure.


SECTION 9. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 10. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
