**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE APPROVING A FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE CLOVERDALE SENIOR MULTIPURPOSE CENTER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$40,000) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT IN A FORM APPROVED BY THE CITY ATTORNEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Cloverdale Senior Multipurpose Center requested funding assistance from the City of Cloverdale; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council allocated \$15,000 in the fy 2021-22 budget to provided funding assistance to the Senior Center for Senior Center Programs and Community Service support; and

**WHEREAS**, the Senior Center subsequently requested an additional funding amount of \$25,000 to augment their original funding request for a total funding request of \$40,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council considered the Cloverdale Senior Multipurpose Center's additional funding request during the discussions on allocation of one-time funding received pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) on October 13, 2021, January 12, 2022 and January 26, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager recommends including the Senior Center funding request for Senior Center programs attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" in a funding agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed funding agreement is for a not to exceed compensation amount of \$40,000, which will be funded by the City's General Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Cloverdale City Council approves a funding agreement with the Cloverdale Senior Center in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) and authorizing the City Manager to execute said agreement in a form approved by the City Attorney.

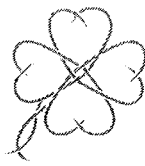

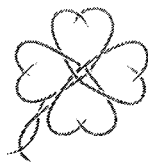
The Cloverdale Senior Multipurpose Center would like to request assistance from the City of Cloverdale to fund a portion of this budget cycle. We want to ask your consideration of \$40,000 for the Senior Center Programs and Community Service support.

#### Senior Center Programs

We move toward opening the Center and bringing back our pre-pandemic programs and outreach services while continuing to navigate the openings and closings according to the Sonoma County Guidelines. We will need to redistribute funding away from current "emergency" focused programs to our general operating needs. Since the pandemic began, we have added the Cloverdale Community Food Insecurity Task Force and Workgroup, food distribution coordination, and other support work resources during the emergency response. Additionally, a goal is to make special efforts toward diversity, equality, and inclusion in our community outreach and programs. We anticipate the need for funding to bridge the financial gap between newly established programs and previously existing programs.

Associations and Community Collaboration Work (With organizations providing community services to seniors and vulnerable populations of the Cloverdale area.) These funds will assist with some of the program costs working in collaboration with other organizations in the community such as La Familia Sana, CERT, The Citrus Fair, Kiwanis, Health Action, and Rotary. In addition, we are building up projects in collaboration with St. Joseph's Healthcare ( Mobile Clinic) and Alexander Valley Health. We are also collaborating with SOS Counseling Services based out of Santa Rosa and the Cloverdale Police Department to bring the Youth Diversion Program to Cloverdale While expanding on Behavioral Health Counseling locally.
